


Tour of the Sirmione Peninsula on Lake Garda



Location: Lombardy **Night(s):** 25 minutes **Language:** Italian, English, German

Overview:

A motorboat excursion to admire the Sirmione Peninsula is **among the ten things not to be missed during a holiday at Lake Garda**.

We will start from the port of the **Scaligero Castle**, skirting the peninsula we will meet the Villa of the twentieth century in which **Maria Callas** was inspired to interpret her characters, we will observe the thermal structure and the Aquaria wellness center, we will stop to imagine where the poet Catullus wrote his poems inside the Roman villa called "**Grotte di Catullo**", we will look through the waves for the bubbles that will indicate the **Boiola sulphurous spring**, from which the beneficial thermal

water of Sirmione is born and finally, after admiring the architecture and the perfect conservation of the **Castle of Sirmione**, we will have to lower our heads to pass under the drawbridge of the castle and return to the port.

We will spend an unforgettable day discovering this famous and poetic Lake, **one of the most beautiful in Italy!**
